LIT members dedicate their time to be in service to the community as leaders in training and. LIT members will assist in operation and administrative tasks of For All programs including Free Summer Meals for Kids, Grocery Rescue and Distribution, For All Vending and Community Box Delivery, and Free Burrito Project.

- Duration is 7 weeks between end June – end August. Location can vary.

Duties include

- Assist in free Summer Meals for Kids site operations including set up, meal service, meal preparation, activities, promotion, recordkeeping, and clean up.
- Help plan and lead activities for children.
- Conduct public outreach to promote Summer Meals for Kids sites and other For All programs.
- Assist in food pickups, sorting, storing and delivery of food donations, vending, and prepared meals in commercial vehicle and/or personal vehicle.
- Assist in bulk meal preparation and other kitchen and warehouse operational tasks.
- Create fliers and other promotional materials for programs.
- Maintain and report records requested
- Positively promote For All with the intention to recruit and expand volunteer and donor base for all programs and services.

Qualifications

- Must be 14-19 years old
- Must be willing and able to pass a national background check
- Must have an enthusiasm for being outside and interacting with kids and teens
- Must be able to lift 25+ pounds and bend repetitively during shifts without physical problems
- Must have or be willing to obtain a King County food handlers permit
- Must work in compliance with all King County health codes and requirements
- Superior sense of cleanliness & food safety in kitchen/warehouse operations and meal preparation
- Strong verbal and written communication skills
- Ability to consistently be on time. Flexible schedule and personality a big plus
- Enthusiasm for environmentally sustainable practices and overall positive attitude

Availability

This position is generally 20 hours/week, 4-5 days/week, 4-5 hr/day shifts, for 7 weeks. Actual scheduling of hours is flexible based on individual availability and area of interest.
