The Women's University Club of Seattle Foundation (WUCF) invites you to apply for one of five \$10,000 scholarships (\$2,500 per year for four years to be used for tuition and fees) to be awarded in April 2024.

The Women's University Club was founded in 1914 to promote educational, cultural and community activities. In the past 100+ years, it has become a diverse community of women pursuing life-long learning and community involvement. In 2003 the Club created the Women's University Club Scholarship Foundation to help expand our outreach to the Seattle-area community.

Selection of the scholarship recipients is based on the applicant's character, scholarship, innovative leadership, and achievements related to her school and community that are above and beyond requirements to graduate. We seek students whose focus is on the humanities and social sciences as well as those with concentration in science, technology, engineering and math (STEM) subjects. Successful candidates reflect the Foundation's values of innovative leadership, civic involvement, and personal growth.

The application period will open on **November 28, 2023** and applications must be received no later than Wednesday, **February 14, 2024**. Please be sure to include the full name of your school. Late or incomplete applications will not be considered.

Scholarship recipients will be notified beginning March 11, 2024 and awards will be presented to the selected recipients at the Brava! Awards Dinner on Wednesday, April 24, 2024. More details will be provided to the recipients later in March. **Attendance at the Brava! Awards Dinner is a condition of receiving the scholarship.**
