PM assemble at **Ballard High School** and transfer to local airport for overnight flight to **New York City**

Wednesday, April 8

New York City



Early morning arrival in **New York City**. Meet your Tour Manager who will be with you for the duration of your stay in New York City. Load and Board your coach and transfer the Park Central Hotel, to store luggage.

Arrive at **Bowling Green** where you enjoy a guided walk through the **Canyon of Heroes** with views of the **Charging Bull**, **Trinity Church Wall Street**, **Federal Hall**, **Wall Street**, **St. Paul's Chapel**, the **9/11 Memorial Garden** and the **Freedom Tower**

Lunch **ON YOUR OWN** at **Brookfield Place**

This afternoon, visit and explore the **High Line**

The High Line is a 1.45-mile-long elevated linear park, greenway and rail trail created on a former New York Central Railroad spur on the west side of Manhattan

Later, transfer to the **Park Central Hotel** for check-in

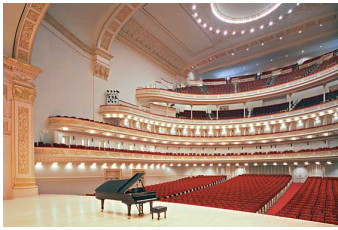
