Funds are not available for applicants attending four-year degree-granting programs; please contact other Rotary Clubs in the Seattle area to inquire about available scholarships for these programs.

Successful applicants will be asked to attend a Ballard Rotary Club meeting in the summer or fall to introduce themselves to club members through a short presentation, and another in the spring to provide an update on your experience and plans for your professional career.
