

# Program Funding

The Seattle Public School district funds the director's salary. **The district gives no additional funds for the program.**

The BHS Performing Arts Programs are funded exclusively from:

- ASB funds (Associated Student Body)
- Ballard Performing Arts Booster Club funds and donations.

# ASB Funds vs Booster Funds

## ASB

### (Associated Student Body)

Funds go to the school's budget.

These funds can cover costs of uniforms (new, dry cleaning and repair), sheet music, instrument repair and replacement, and transportation for day fieldtrips. **These funds cannot be used to pay for additional instruction or scholarships.**


## Boosters Club

Boosters budget can pay for any BPA related expense but we choose to use the money to fill the void of what ASB cannot, by law pay for.

This includes scholarships and additional instruction.

The balance of our budget covers other program costs, fundraising and administrative costs.

# Program Fees

These fees cover the annual costs per student.

None of the Program Fees go to the Boosters budget.

# Program Fees

Fees for the entire year are listed below\* so you can know what to expect. Types of fees are:

Annual Fee

Additional concert wear needs

Camp Fee

Overnight Trip Fee

ASB card (for all band students)

Class fees for Jazz Bands I, II and percussion

(\*some trips are not yet confirmed for Jazz I)

# Annual Fees

This fee is for ALL students.

Cost \$150.00 due Sept 15th

This covers the cost of uniforms (new, repair, and cleaning), sheet music, festival fees, program t-shirt, and transportation for all day field trips.

# **Additional Concert Wear costs**

**Concert wear** is loaned out for the entire school year. Students keep at home. Students are responsible for the clothing, the garment bag and the hanger.

**Students must provide:**

Ladies: hose and low heeled black shoes

Men: tux shirt, studs, (approx. \$25 from Ted Brown Music) black socks & dress shoes.

You do not need to dry clean during the year but you should wash the tux shirt.

# Camp Fees

The camp fees cover the actual cost of camp.  
This usually includes transportation,  
accommodations, coaching, and some meals.

Choir and Orchestra Camp \$170

Band Camp \$180

All past due at this time.

(Band camp costs a little more because the cost of the camp location.)

# Overnight Trip Fees

Some groups may go on overnight trips during the school year. The fee is charged only to those going on the trip. The fee includes costs of transportation, accommodations, festival/entry fees, and some meals.

(Trip fees are not covered by any of the Annual Fees.)

# How to pay for fees?

All fees may be paid

**by check**, payable to BPA and returned to black mailbox in music room or

**by credit card** online with no processing fees @

If you create an account before you pay you will be able to go back and review if you made a payment. You can also print out a receipt after online payment is made. There is no receipt issued if paying by cash or check.

# ASB Cards

Mandatory for all band members.


This \$35.00 fee can be paid through School Pay or at the fiscal office at BHS (in the Commons)

You can't pay for this on the boosters payment site.

The ASB card allows band members performing at football & basketball games free entrance.

ASB cards also have the benefit of a reduced price all other sports games and for BHS Yearbooks.
