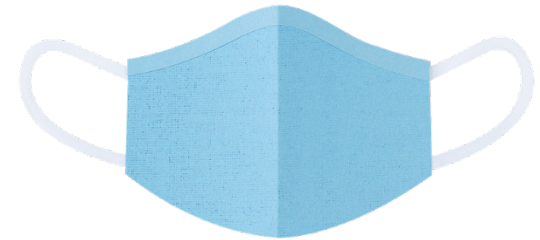

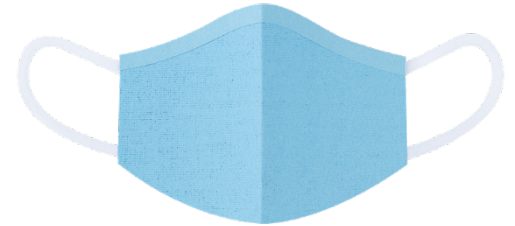
Health Information and Procedures



Safety Expectations

- Masks are required on all participants and guests at all times
- Safety stations with hand sanitizer and extra masks will be available
- Social distancing is encouraged when arriving, entering, sitting in, and departing the stadium
- Pod seating is required for all guests; graduates and school staff will be seated on the stadium field using 6'X6' safety guidelines

Health Information and Procedures



Attestation

- Students are required to complete the daily attestation process in use at school; Select Memorial Stadium as the location
- Students without access to a QR reader and unable to show email verification of passing the attestation will be required to complete an on-site attestation document
- If a student is in quarantine due to close contact tracing, or is unable to meet the attestation requirements, they will not be allowed to enter the stadium
- Guests will self-attest as they enter the stadium per the COVID-19 posters on each entry gate

 - Wristbands are color specific to school

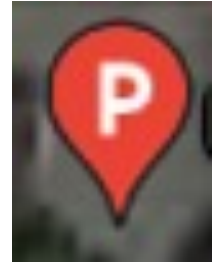
Graduation Day



Graduates and Families:

- Graduates should arrive to Memorial Stadium between 4:30 and 4:45 – well before the 5:30 ceremony start time.
- Graduating seniors will line up to enter the stadium at the lower NE entrance (see map)
- Guests will line up at either the upper SE or NE stadium entrance (see map and ticket)
- Guest entry will begin approximately 45 minutes before the start of the graduation ceremony
- Guests must have wristbands on and tickets in possession to enter Memorial stadium

Parking Information



Parking around Memorial Stadium

- See map on slide 11 for options
 - Option 1: Memorial Stadium parking lot with limited parking due to COVID restriction
 - Option 2: Gates Foundation parking lot directly east of stadium
 - Option 3: Mercer Street Garage one block north of stadium
 - Option 4: Various other pay lots or street parking is located around the stadium
- All parking is fee based, with different rates based on the type and location of the parking space

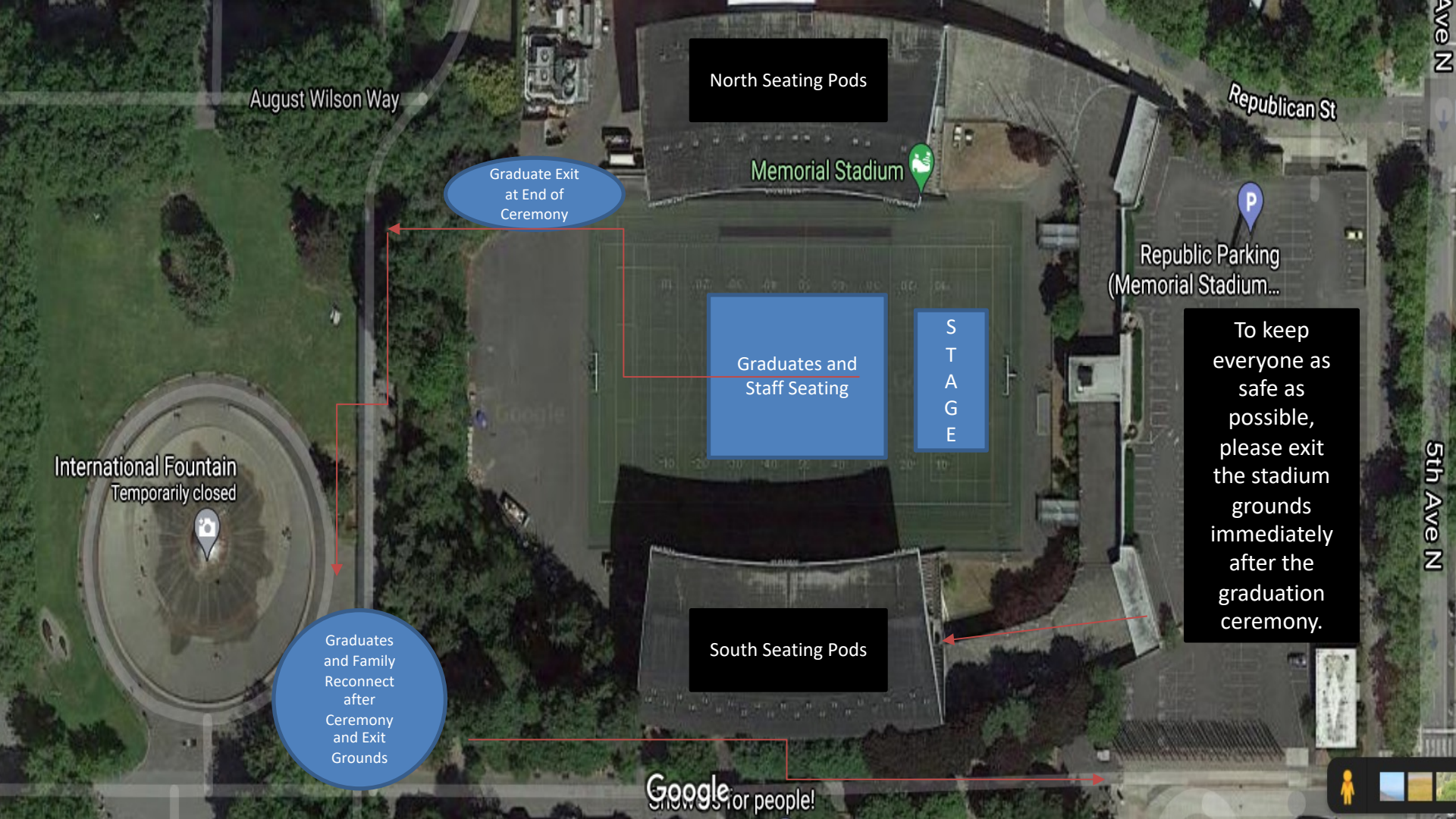
2021 Graduate Seating
