Day 1, Friday April 5th

ARRIVAL IN SICILY: PALERMO

- Arrival in Italy: Palermo. You will meet your local escort at the airport.

The walking tour through the old squares and street markets of the city centre, includes several stops at bakeries, street vendors and old inns to taste the delicious street food of Palermo and a selection of Sicilian sweet wines. 

 Pick-up by your private driver & transfer to your hotel in Ragusa; along the way, you will stop for a beautiful visit of


Agrigento & Valley of Temples.

- You will visit the incredible archaeological park of Valle Dei Templi, where you will admire the finest of all ancient Greek sites, with complete Doric Temple. It is one of the most outstanding examples of Greater Greece art and architecture, and is one of the main attractions of Sicily as well as a national monument of Italy. The monumental ruins of ancient Akrégas represent one of the most important archaeological complexes in the Mediterranean area. They stand out in an agricultural landscape that is characterised by centuries-old olive and almond trees. Your tour will develop along the rocky crest of Temple Hill. A series of out-of-town sanctuaries consecrated to the most important Polias Gods have decorated this crest since the late sixth century BC. Starting from the Temple of Juno to the Olympieion, you will be the protagonists of an imaginary trip among the Templar Greek architecture that here, as in few other places, has kept its formal perfection intact. You will then go to Girgenti Hill, which was probably the acropolis of the Greek city, where the medieval town was located.
- After the tour, we will book for you a delicious lunch in the typical local restaurant Trattoria Dei Templi.

 flavour that it will probably follow us up to Modica. This city
 was the capital of one of the most important feudal states in
 Southern Italy. Here, you will discover the local ancient
 method to make chocolate under the expert guide of Katia
 who will be sharing the secrets of her grandma Nonna Elvira
 with you in her house in the heart of the city.

Starting from a visit to the small fishing village of Marzamemi where you will see the different phases of the processing of tuna you will then proceed with one of the most ancient fish businesses in Sicily. Therefore, you will get to know and taste the many different aspects of tuna.

 We will book for you a delicious lunch in Marzamemi at II Cortile Arabo: a restaurant with a beautiful terrace overlooking the Mediterranean.

 Before reaching Siracusa if time allows, you will stop in Noto, the most precious example of Baroque art in Sicily. This little town is called a Stone Garden because of all the incredible decorations in the buildings. It is listed indeed among the UNESCO World Heritage Sites, because provides outstanding testimony to the exuberant genius of late Baroque art and architecture. It represents the culmination and final flowering of Baroque art in Europe.

CathedralThe hotel, founded in 1880, is framed on one side by the cathedral and on the other by the Archbishop's Palace and overlooks Piazza Minerva, which is a continuation of the Piazza Duomo that runs alongside the Doric columns of the Temple, and onto Siracusa's most central road, Via Roma. When the cathedral was the Temple of Minerva (known as Athena by the Greeks), as in all Greek temples the entrance was facing east. The stairway was therefore located inside the hotel, and some of its remains are still visible through glass panels in our floors.




