There is a particular beauty in the way this text is written – calm, thoughtful, built piece-by-piece into a rational, theologically grounded case against the unquestioned embrace of Artificial Intelligence. Not because AI is evil *per se*, but that it threatens to too-easily undermine the dignity and flourishing of the humanity it is, presumably, meant to assist. In a world where everyone shouts, it is good to sit with careful thought for a while!
