The National Sustainability Teachers' Academy provides K-12 teachers with the knowledge, skills and tools to become agents of change. By infusing sustainability concepts and practices into schools, teachers can have a profound impact on motivating future leaders to create and innovate solutions to the economic, social and environmental challenges of our world.

Program Details:

- Two-person teams of current K-12 teachers from the same school or district are encourage to apply
- Teachers of all subjects are welcome
- Selected teams will participate in a hands-on, five day professional development workshop
- Within one year of the workshop, teams will complete a sustainability project in their school
- Each individual will receive a \$700 stipend for participating in the workshop
- Participating teachers will be elligible for an additional \$300 stipend for implementing a sustainbility project with their students
- Lodging, meals and travel allowance are also paid for by the Academy
