Placement & Code Compliance ☐ House is positioned according to approved site plan ☐ Setbacks from property lines and structures are correct ☐ Site plan matches final layout on the ground
Utility Hookups ☐ Water connection installed and tested ☐ Wastewater system connected and functioning ☐ Electrical hookup completed, inspected, and code-compliant ☐ Gas line (if used) professionally installed and permitted
Required Exterior Installations ☐ Stairs, decks, and railings installed and secure ☐ Skirting/screening installed if required by jurisdiction ☐ Home is anchored or stabilized per code, if required ☐ All features meet local building and safety codes
Insurance & Documentation ☐ Proof of home insurance coverage in place ☐ Permit documents and approvals on hand for inspector
Finishing Touches ☐ Outdoor lighting and address visible (if required) ☐ Landscaping complete or planned (some areas may require erosion control or plant buffers) ☐ Site is tidy and safe for inspection
