## Parking at the Meeting House

It's been a while since we've had a full house at the Meeting House, and many things have changed since the pandemic began, like no more parking on Elmwood Avenue. So here is a reminder to both new visitors and longtime members of where to park at the Meeting House. Please plan ahead, as finding parking may take longer than it has in the past.

- 1. Sunday Mornings: The row of parking directly behind the Meeting House is reserved for people who need handicapped parking, whether or not you have a sticker. Please leave the oval parking on the east side of the building available for visitors who may not know where to find other parking spaces. Others may park in the lots behind the building (both the paved area and the gravel area). If there are no available parking spots in the lots behind the building, you will need to seek parking on the street, or in one of the <u>city parking structures</u> on Cherry Street. City parking is free on Sundays.
- 2. **Monday Friday:** During the daytime, the lots behind our building are rented out. You may not park there unless you have a sticker to park in the back lot. After 4 p.m. you may park in the lots behind the building wherever there is space available. If you have purchased a parking tag for the oval, you may park in the oval on the east side of the building at any time Monday-Friday for no longer than 3 hours at a time between 8 a.m. and 11 p.m. (no tag needed if you are here on FUUSB business).
- 3. **Saturdays:** On Saturdays, you may park in the lots behind the building or in the oval.
- 4. **Special Events:** When there is a special event, such as a Wedding or a Memorial Service that is held in the evening or on a weekend, you may park in the lots behind the building. If all the spaces are occupied, you will need to find parking on the street or in one of the <u>city parking structures</u> on Cherry Street.
- 5. Important Notice: There is no longer any parking available in the Elmwood Ave. lot due to the construction of the homeless pods. Please plan ahead.
- 6. **Overnight Parking:** There is no overnight parking allowed in any of our spaces. Any car left in our lot overnight will be towed.
