First UU Society Member Parking Guidelines

- Please place the parking tag somewhere inside your front windshield, visible from outside.
- Your parking permit expires on September 30 of next year.
- It allows you to park in the Meeting House Oval for a maximum of three hours at a time between 8 a.m. and 11 p.m.
- You do not need a parking tag if you are at the Meeting House for a FUUSBrelated purpose.
- There may be parking restrictions during weddings, memorial services and other events. Signs may indicate "For Ceremony Guests Only." Please respect the signs on these occasions.
- We issue 50 member passes and there are just eight spaces available. It is possible that all spaces will be taken when you arrive.
- Parking is *not* allowed in the lots behind the Meeting House Monday through Friday between 7 a.m. and 5 p.m.
- Overnight parking is never allowed without permission. Your vehicle will be towed.
- Snow and ice may slide off the Meeting House roof and damage parked cars. Parking spots may be blocked off with orange cones or yellow caution tape during heavy snow accumulations or for buildings and grounds work.
