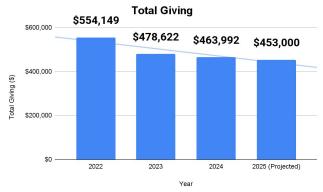

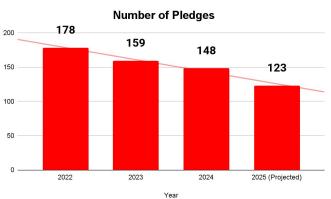

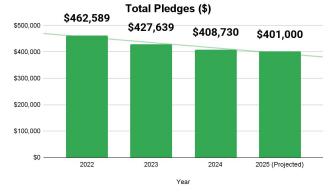

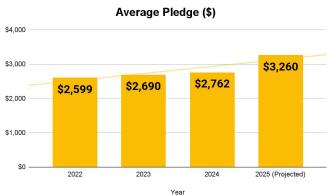

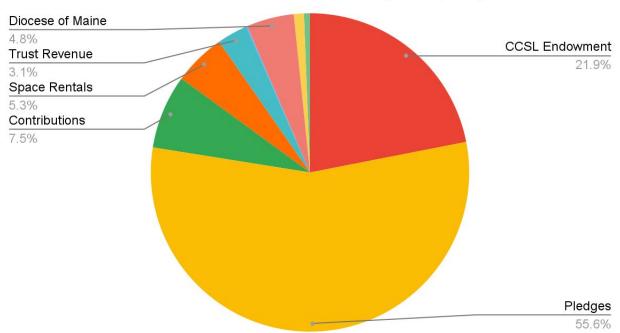






Financial Overview: 2024

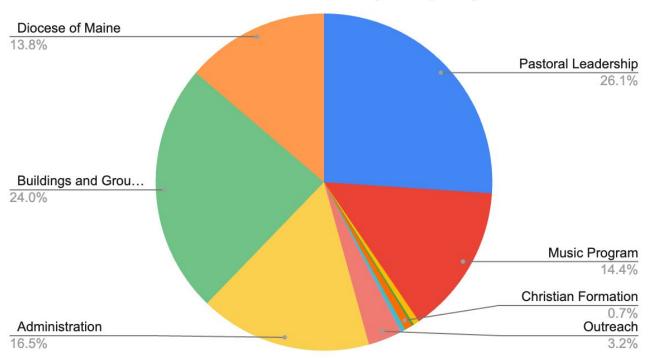
2024 Sources of Income (\$735,134)

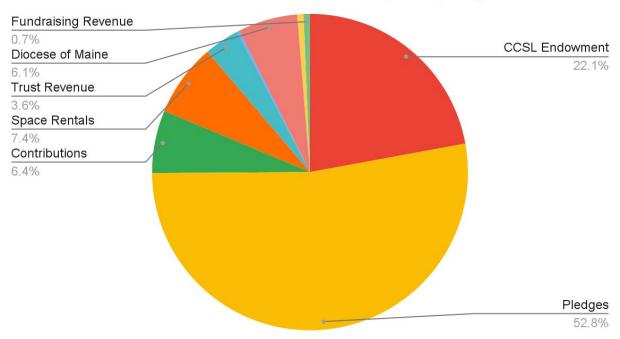

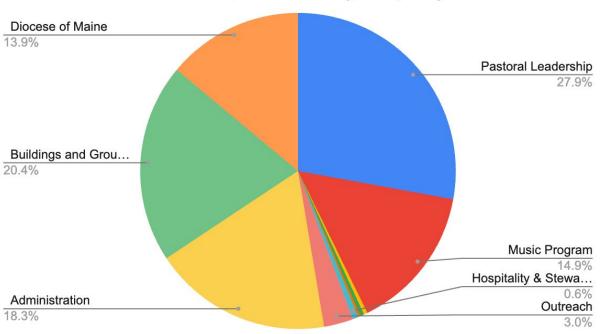
2025 Sources of Income (\$765,215)

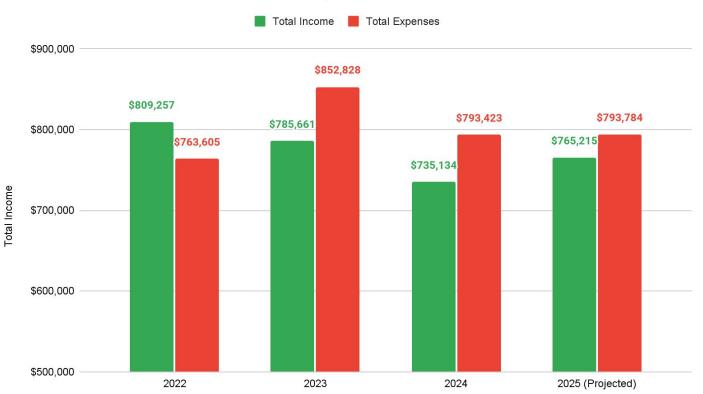
2025 Expenditures (\$793,784)
