RELAY FOR LIFE 2025 - AUGUST 22, 5:00pm-9:00pm.

In the following, Jerry Vitalis shares some background and history on the on the Chisago County Relay for Life event!



Some History on Relay for Life

I became a cancer survivor in 2001 and was invited to the Relay for Life event held at Chisago Lakes High School. The north end of Chisago County held their event at North Branch High School. CLLC was one of 8 teams in South Chisago County who fundraised for the American Cancer Society. Our church team was always the top

fundraiser. I remember walking the track, it was important that some one walked all night long in memory of those who lost their battle.

A few years later the two Relays in Chisago County combined and we moved our Relay first



to the Tanger Mall, then to the Almelund Threshing Show grounds. This must have been the time we started selling and displaying the luminaries. Note the picture of the luminaries on both sides of the track at the threshing grounds. We had regular sized candles that would stay lit all night while some walked the track in memory of those lost to cancer. Families would come with their tents and camp all night long.

We were at Almelund for many years but it did come to an end. The grounds posed issues having to park and walk on uneven, hilly terrain making it difficult for some.

We then returned to the Tanger Outlet Mall parking lot for two years but that was not ideal either without shade or building use available, but we had no other place to go at that time.

Then I received a memo saying that due to Covid there would be no Relay until further notice. I met with our new pastor, Taryn Montgomery and noting that I sell most of the luminaries, told her I was going to have my own Relay. Pastor Taryn suggested that since we can't have anything inside let's have it outside along the retaining wall of the church. The rest is history!

You will hear much more about the Relay through the bulletin over next weeks. We have a great team led by Chris Lundberg. As my dad would say about Chris, "If you want something done, ask those who are too busy because they are the only ones who have time."
