

3/30/2025 - Cottage Meeting Introduction – by Lori Sampson, Council President:

Welcome you to today's cottage meeting regarding the upcoming capital campaign and the many projects that await attention here at Chisago Lake Lutheran Church.

Our property committee has worked very hard at putting together and prioritizing a project list and has made recommendations for the capital campaign. A huge thank you to the property committee for their efforts.

In just a few moments you'll be viewing a power point presentation which shows some of the many projects that are needed and wanted for our facility.

Before we get to a power point, let me summarize the broad areas these projects are grouped in.

With regard to **Safety and Security** – thank you to the task force for their collaboration with property committee and council for working in prioritizing the Church's needs. These projects include doors in sanctuary, narthex and education wing. Which involves, replacement, installation of panic bars, ADA compliant access and keyless access system. Updated security cameras will allow us to better monitor our church. Exterior lighting updates. A secure desk for the media station area.

There are projects on the list that will result in **beautification** of our Church which in actuality are the completion of projects, cyclical maintenance and updates to our facility. These projects could include completing the patio/deck area off of the narthex, window replacement, flooring updates, bathroom updates.

Lighting projects, may include LED steeple lighting, LED conversion updates on first level and outdoor parking lot and perimeter lighting. These lighting projects along with the door and window replacement may very well result in **energy** savings which could lower our utility costs.
