Historical Fun Facts –One of the Swedish traditions that our early church members kept was constructing horse stables near the church. Old photographs

taken from the church site looking east show some of these tiny shelters. After the new brick church was built in 1882, several large stables were also built. Gary Anderson has an 1883 legal document of his great-great grandfather leasing an 11x15 foot lot from the church trustees for the price of \$7. It was a one-time payment for him and his heirs to use as long as the church kept the building. At a meeting of the congregation in 1928 a committee was authorized to dispose of the church stables and \$300 was appropriated to be used, if necessary, to pay for razing them. Thus passed the horse and buggy era. (see 150 Years of Ministry, page 226.)
