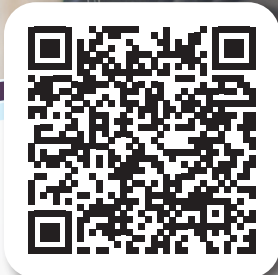

Electrical Technology is a program that provides the basic skills needed for entry into residential and light commercial applications in the electrical field. Students will get hands-on training and will place conduits, pipes, and tubing inside designated partitions, walls and other concealed areas, as well as pull insulated wires and cables to complete circuits.

Students who complete the program will receive their Level 1 certificate and an Industry Board certificate through National Center for Construction Education & Research (NCCER).
