Following delivery of kits, facility must collect all samples within 24 hours of receiving kits in order to maintain integrity of samples. ISDH will collect samples for processing.
- Nursing facilities that selected option of onsite testing conducted at the facility; onsite testing between June 23–28, over a 4 hour period.
