FOREST ORDER

Pursuant to 36 CFR, Section 261.50 (a), it is hereby ordered that the following prohibition hereinafter set forth applies to Citico Creek Campsite #14 (Warden Field), Tellico Ranger District, Cherokee National Forest, shown on the attached map. **This order is in effect until a period of two years from the signature date or until terminated by an authorized Forest Service official, whichever occurs first.**


- 1. Camping within the Citico Campsite # 14 (Warden Field) (36 CFR 261.58(e)).**

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(e) the following persons are exempt from the above prohibitions:

- 1. Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of their official duty.**

These prohibitions are in addition to the general prohibitions in 36 CFR Part 261, Subpart A.

A violation of these prohibitions is punishable by a fine of not more than \$5,000 for an individual or \$10,000 for an organization, or imprisonment for not more than 6 months, or both. 16 USC 551 and 18 USC 3559, 3571 and 3581.
