

DAY 1

MONDAY, AUGUST 3 | DEPART THE USA FOR DUBLIN, IRELAND

DAY 2

TUESDAY, AUGUST 4 | ARRIVE IN DUBLIN, IRELAND

Arrive in Dublin airport and meet the guide and driver. Overnight in Dublin at the Clayton Burlington Hotel.


Glasnevin Cemetery


- Experience Ireland's National Cemetery and connect through the stories of those buried here. The cemetery has been beautifully restored including state-of-the-art exhibition, education facilities, a visitor center, and interactive tours.

Dublin

- Visit the Dublin city center which covers about 1,000 years of history from the first Viking developments on the edge of the River Liffey through to the walled city of the Middle Ages.
- See O'Connell Street, where the fight for independence started in 1916 at the G.P.O., and Phoenix Park where the Irish President and the American Ambassador live surrounded by a herd of wild deer!
- Tour Trinity College Dublin and view the Book of Kells. Trinity College is Ireland's oldest university and home to its greatest cultural treasure, the Book of Kells. This artifact is a precious 9th century manuscript containing the four Gospels of the New Testament. It is on display in the Old Library Long Room which is considered to be one of the world's most beautiful libraries.
- Enjoy an Irish night in a pub—possibly the Merry Ploughboy or Johnnie Foxs.

WEDNESDAY, AUGUST 5 | NEWGRANGE / CHESTER BEATTY

Following a hearty Irish breakfast at the hotel, the group will set out to Newgrange followed for an afternoon visit to the Chester Beatty Library. Dinner and overnight in Dublin at the Clayton Burlington.

Newgrange

- Begin at the Brú na Bóinne Visitor Centre, a fully interactive visitor experience exploring the Neolithic culture, landscape, and monuments of Brú na Bóinne.

Chester Beatty

- Situated in the heart of Dublin city center, the Chester Beatty exhibitions open a window on the artistic treasures of the great cultures and religions of the world—Asia, Middle East, North Africa and Europe. This world-renowned, award-winning museum showcases rich and diverse exhibitions of miniature paintings, decorative arts, manuscripts, prints and drawings. All items were donated to the Irish nation by American mining magnate and philanthropist, Sir Alfred Chester Beatty (1875-1968).

THURSDAY, AUGUST 6 | GLENDALOUGH / KILKENNY

After an Irish breakfast at the hotel, the group will head south to the glorious garden county of Wicklow, known for its shades of green and mountains. Dinner and overnight in Kilkenny at the Hotel Kilkenny.

Glendalough

- Explore a monastic site established by St. Kevin in the 6th Century. This site is an isolated but beautiful place where St. Kevin could live as a hermit without distraction. Slowly it developed into an ancient monastery and place of learning for medieval monks. The ruins include a small chapel, an ancient Irish round tower, and a cemetery in a remote valley and lake.

Kilkenny

- Discover medieval Ireland including a visit to the Kilkenny Castle. Kilkenny is one of the best-preserved medieval towns in Ireland. The historic highlight will be a visit to the fine Norman castle of Kilkenny.

5

FRIDAY, AUGUST 7 | CASHEL

Following the Irish breakfast at the hotel, the group will head to Cashel, one of Ireland's most spectacular archaeological sites. Following Cashel, continue to Killarney. Dinner and overnight in Killarney at the Killarney Plaza Hotel.


Cashel

- At the Rock of Cashel, meander among the medieval buildings including the ruins of a 12th-century Gothic church.
- Also known as Cashel of the Kings and St. Patrick's Rock, it is a historical site located dramatically above a plain at Cashel, County Tipperary.



RING OF KERRY

DAY 6

SATURDAY, AUGUST 8 | RING OF KERRY / KILLARNEY

Starting with an Irish breakfast at the hotel, the group will have an early departure and head to the Ring of Kerry and Killarney. Dinner and overnight in Killarney at the Killarney Plaza Hotel.

Ring of Kerry

- Explore significant historical sites and stunning views along this 111-mile circular route.
- Be amazed by the broad Iveragh Peninsula stretching southwest from Killarney for nearly 40 miles.
- Stop en-route to watch a sheepdog demonstration. These dogs are renowned for the talent, agility, and skills.
- See ancient Ring Forts—enclosed farmsteads from the Early Christian / Early Medieval period.
- Visit Muckross House, a 19th century Victorian mansion set in the heart of Killarney National Park. Muckross is known throughout the world for its scenic beauty and cultural attractions, including the magnificent house itself, craft workshops, the Garden Restaurant, and the 1920's style working farm.

DAY 7


SUNDAY, AUGUST 9 | DINGLE PENINSULA

Beginning with an Irish breakfast the hotel, the day will be filled with a scenic drive to the Dingle Peninsula and exploration of its rugged beauty. Dinner and overnight in Killarney at the Killarney Plaza Hotel.

Dingle Peninsula

- Be amazed by Dingle Peninsula, located on Ireland's southwest Atlantic coast. This area is ringed by sandy beaches, craggy cliffs, rolling hills, and mountains.
- Visit Dingle, a small port town on southwest Ireland's Dingle Peninsula, known for scenery

MONDAY, AUGUST 10 | CLIFFS OF MOHER (VIA TARBERT FERRY) / BURREN

After a full Irish breakfast at the hotel, head to the Cliffs of Moher, followed by a visit to the Burren, and ending in Galway. Dinner and overnight in Galway at the Salthill Hotel.

Cliffs of Moher

- Arrive via the Tarbert Ferry, the most direct route.
- Visit the famous Cliffs of Moher along with the Atlantic Edge Exhibition. Walk along the pathway up to the O'Briens Tower.

Doolin

- Enjoy lunch in Doolin. This village is known for its traditional Irish music and location in the unique Burren landscape.


The Burren

- See the famous Poulnebrone Dolmen, a large dolmen situated on one of the region's most desolate and highest points. It comprises three standing portal stones supporting a heavy horizontal capstone and dates to the early Neolithic period, 3800 and 3200 BC.
- The Burren is an area of karst vegetation where the porous limestone has allowed the rain to flow through, creating a network of underground rivers, lakes, and waterfalls.
- View the alpine and arctic flora as well as birds among the many ancient burial chambers, tombs and dolmens.


Galway

- Continue to Galway, a harbor city on Ireland's west coast.

TUESDAY, AUGUST 11 | GALWAY / CLONMACNOISE / DUBLIN

Starting with an Irish breakfast at the hotel, the day's activities will start in Galway, proceed to Clonmacnoise, and end in Dublin. Dinner and overnight in Dublin at the Herbert Park Hotel.

Galway

- Take a short walking tour of Galway, a city filled with stone-clad cafes, boutiques, and art galleries in the winding lanes. Portions of the medieval city walls remain.

Clonmacnoise

- Drive to Clonmacnoise, a monastery situated in County Offaly. The ruins include a cathedral, two round towers, three high crosses, nine churches, and more than 700 early Christian graves
- St. Ciarán founded this monastery on the banks of the River Shannon in the 6th Century. It flourished and became a great seat of learning with students from throughout Europe.

RESERVATION AND PAYMENT SCHEDULE. A non-refundable deposit of \$500 per person is required to reserve your space. Reservations received inside 90 days of departure must be accompanied with full payment. Late payment will result in a late payment fee of \$95 per person if received in the Faith Based Expeditions™ office within 14 days after final payment due date. This 14-day period is referred to as "Late Payment Period." If the final payment has not been received within the "Late Payment Period," then the participant/s will be notified in writing and immediately removed from the tour manifest and subject to the cancellation penalty outlined in the "Cancellation Penalties for Standard Tours" section in the Faith Based Expeditions Terms and Conditions.

CANCELLATION BY ANY INDIVIDUAL TOUR REGISTRANTS OR IF A TOUR LEADER CANCELS AN ENTIRE TOUR FOR ANY REASON THE BELOW PENALTIES WILL APPLY:

The below cancellation penalties and refund policy will apply for all travelers who choose not to abide by a country's official travel restrictions.

- If a Tour Leader cancels an entire tour for any reason all tour registrants on the manifest at the time of cancellation will be penalized \$500 per person plus non-refundable payments to our suppliers.
- Any individual canceling between the date of registration and the Final Payment Due Date (Final Payment Due Date is 100 days prior to the tour departure date) will be penalized \$500 per person non-refundable and non-transferable administrative cost plus any non-refundable third-party supplier costs.
- Any individual canceling between 99 - 85 days prior to the scheduled departure date we will be penalized the entire tour deposit plus 10% of the total tour cost and any nonrefundable payments to any third-party supplier.
- Individual canceling prior to scheduled departure day—total tour cost penalty plus any non-refundable payments made to any third-party supplier.: 84-55 days: 50% penalty, 54-45 days: 80% penalty, 44-0 days: 100% penalty
- Any individual canceling less than 60 days prior to the tour departure date and causes their assigned roommate to room alone and if there is no one to be assigned as the person's roommate, then the person canceling will be responsible to pay the Single Supplement fee. If a roommate is subsequently found for the remaining roommate, then the Single Supplement fee will be refunded to the canceling individual.
- Allow 8 weeks for any refund to be issued.
