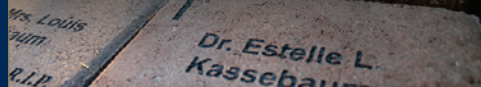

Donations of \$500 or more will receive a Memorial Brick in the "Garden of Remembrance" next to Marian Chapel.

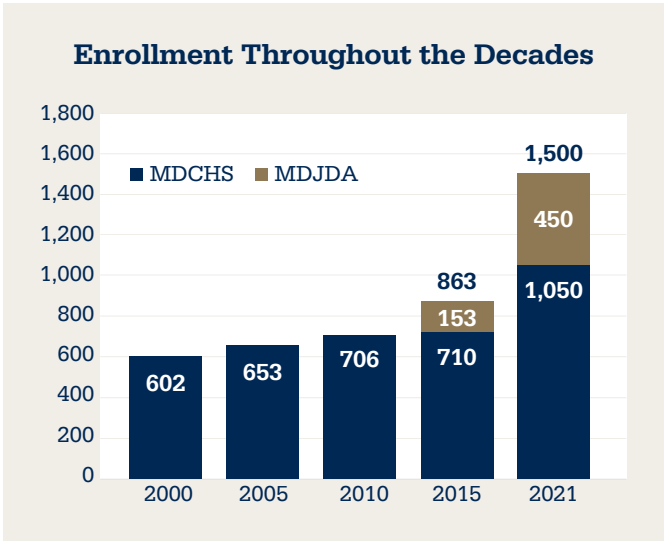

The Exceptional Value and Impact of a Mater Dei Catholic Education

Mater Dei Catholic has evolved over the past six decades to become a TK-12 school. Our story began 60 years ago in Imperial Beach when Marian High School was founded as the first coed Catholic high school in San Diego. It was located on a small campus yet had a distinct and powerful spirit that inspired its students to love, know, and serve God both on and off campus.

Our transformation began in 1995 when Estelle Kassebaum (Dr. K) joined Marian High School. With great zest and a vision to re-energize and restore the school, she reinvented Marian Catholic High School and forged a plan to move it to a new, bigger, and more beautiful campus east of Imperial Beach.



In 2007, Mater Dei Catholic High School opened its doors on a 48-acre campus in Otay Ranch, Chula Vista. In 2015, Mater Dei Juan Diego Academy began with four grades (TK-2) and became the first Catholic dual-language immersion program in San Diego. In 2021, Mater Dei Catholic became the largest TK-12th grade Catholic school and second largest private school in San Diego.

FINANCIAL GAP.

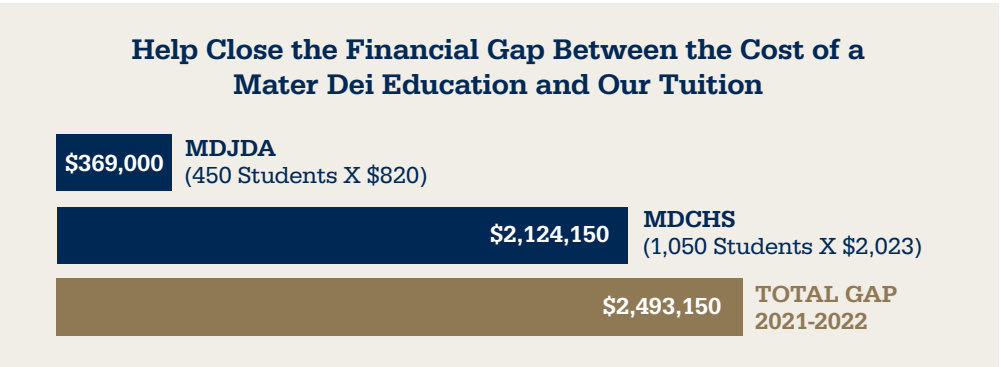
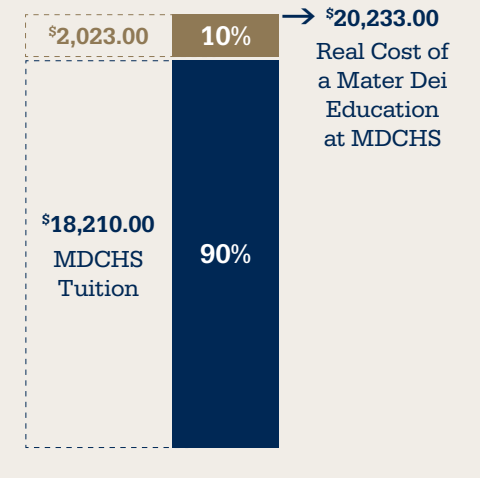
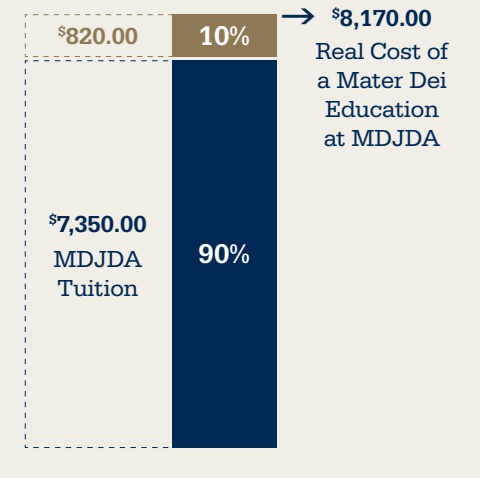
Currently, money received from tuition only covers approximately 90% of the total cost to educate each student. The remaining 10% is what we call the *Financial Gap*. This is the difference between the cost of a Mater Dei Catholic education and our tuition. Each year our community of parents, alumni, faculty and friends help us close this 10% *Financial Gap* by making a tax-deductible donation to the Mater Dei Fund.
