

Body



Paint and minor bodywork was professionally completed using a base coat, clear coat paint process. It was repainted in the beautiful Color of Ford Beige. The vehicle was disassembled for proper frame off restoration procedures. The chassis was sandblasted, pained and detailed. The body was sandblasted to bare metal as required. Replacement fender welting is installed. Floor pans have been replaced and new wood has been installed. The trunk floor has been repaired as required. Replacement wood installed has been changed to maple for strength, longevity and durability. New body mounts and fasteners have been installed. New running boards are mounted.

Engine



Underneath the hood lies the engine Inline 6 cylinder, 100 HP mated to the 3-speed manual transmission that is well detailed. This includes the correct fittings, wiring, clamps, hoses, and necessary components. Reliable Engine Builders of Calgary, rebuilt the engine new pistons, guides, and bored .030 over. The undercarriage is tidy and completely solid as expected. Motor is completely Original and is 100% correct including the air cleaner all the way down to the oil pan assembly. No modification has been performed to the drive train and still runs beautifully. Drive train is in Very Good Original condition. Engine compartment is clean and tidy with no major signs of leaks or rust to any of the under carriage that can be seen. Extensive work has been performed and attention to detail as well as the quality of this superb restoration.

- The master cylinder was rebuilt and the front & rear drums were machined.
- The wooden wheels have been completely rebuilt
- Front-end components were replaced, such as tie rod ends, ball joints, etc.
- The steering box has been rebuilt.



Bumpers



The re-chromed front bumper is straight and free of accident damage or corrosion. The headlights are free of any rock chips or damage. The re-chromed rear bumper is straight and free of accident damage or corrosion. Rear lights are free of cracks or chips. The mounts for the rear split style bumper are in Very Good and appears to be free of any damage.

The steering wheel installed has been refurbished.


The chrome dash bezels and trim are in new condition.

Panels



The Beige Leather door panels fit is Very Good with uniform gaps and no pinch points. Doors open and close easily, with no sagging or binding. Door panels are free of holes and tears.

A set of side curtains are installed to enhance the originality of the 1928 Roadster of that era. Attention to detail and quality of workmanship throughout the entire restoration is easy to see.

Trim



All of the stainless bright work and chromed areas in Very Good condition with no signs of scratches or pitting. All trim pieces are present and have a brilliant finish. Glass is in Very Good condition with no signs of marks or scratches on the windows. The rad support shell and headlights show beautifully and were all re-chromed at the time of the restoration.

Rumble Seat



The car includes the hidden rear rumble seat that was done in the same Beige Leather as the rest of the Interior. Carpet show no sign of wear and has probably never had anyone sitting in there. Trunk is clean and tidy and shows no signs of wear.

Trunk



The car includes the jack set, tool kit, spare wheel and tire, books, 2 sets of keys, service records, etc. Trunk is clean and tidy and shows no signs of wear. Very seldom do you find these cars with all of the tools and accessories.



Tops




Under Carriage




Chrysler Series 72, 6 Cylinder

A higher radiator and cowl were used on the Chrysler 72. Headlight posts were now firmly attached to the frame of the cars.

Standard equipment included hydraulic brakes, tubular front axle, rubber shock insulators on springs, and a new oblong instrument panel.

Throttle and headlight controls were repositioned on a thinner new steering wheel.
