2 Day Intensive on Classroom Discipline

Vision: The goal of this two-day intensive is to ensure that teachers have the foundational knowledge, skills, and mindsets to enter the classroom to take on basic student behaviors and take a proactive approach to teaching and reinforcing behaviors. Teachers will review some of the basic routines that are required to teach in the first days of school and ensure that they know the processes for teaching these routines.
