The Steering Committee for Aquaculture America 2020 is looking for students entries to design the logo for the World Aquaculture Society's annual conference in 2020. The logo for this conference should take into account the theme: **"Hawai'i Aquaculture: A Tradition of Navigating with Innovation, Technology and Culture"** and the unique location and aquaculture history in Hawai'i. The Hawaiian islands are isolated by 2,500 miles of surrounding ocean, yet the food resources of the islands once supported a population of as many as 800,000 people. Loko i'a – traditional Hawaiian fishponds – played a crucial role in supporting that population. Thus, Hawai'i is home to the one of the world's oldest mariculture traditions and the modern aquaculture community hopes to share the continued spirit of innovation and ingenuity with the rest of the world.

Logo Submission Requirements:

- The **deadline** for submission(s) is December 15, 2018. **Deadline extended to Jan 15, 2019!**
- Submissions will be eligible from **any student** currently enrolled in courses or research hours in Hawai'i (must provide proof of student status with a photo or scan of Student ID, or written verification by a teacher or advisor).

- Digital designs must be submitted in either JPEG or TIFF format. Submissions can be hand sketched and after evaluation, may be submitted to third party graphic designers for construction and finishing.
- After the deadline, eligible entries will be evaluated by a panel of AA2020 Steering Committee members. The winner will be required to sign a release form giving permission for WAS to use the logo in all conference materials and promotions.
