

## VIDEO DIVISION

Middle School | Grades 6-8 (Individual or Team Entry)

First Place	\$350 Team, \$100 Teacher
Second Place	\$250 Team, \$100 Teacher
Third Place	\$100 Team, \$100 Teacher

High School | Grades 9-12 (Individual or Team Entry)

First Place	\$500 Team, \$100 Teacher
Second Place	\$400 Team, \$100 Teacher
Third Place	\$300 Team, \$100 Teacher

\*Teacher awards are capped at \$500.



**Who can enter?** The contest is open to students in Kindergarten through Grade 12 who are current residents of the State of Hawaii. Students may only enter one division.

**What must an entry include?** An entry must identify an existing problem in Hawaii and offer a thoughtful solution to the problem. **How will students know if they won?** Award winners will be contacted through their schools/teachers and invited to the awards program in February 2020.
