80th Anniversary Calendar Contest Celebrating Hawaii's Labor Past, Present, and Future

The Hawaii State Department of Labor and Industrial Relations (DLIR) is preparing to enter its 80th year of service to the people of Hawaii. In tribute of this service, the DLIR is looking to commission a 2020 calendar dedicated to celebrating Hawaii's labor past, present, and future through the eyes of Hawaii's future: our keiki.

This contest is available statewide to both public and private education institutions and students (18 and under). The contest shall have a total of 12 winners in 3 categories (Past, Present, and Future). Each category will have four winners. Entries are limited to one per person. The winning artwork and photo image will be reproduced in a DLIR calendar that shall be distributed statewide, displayed in the Hawaii State Capitol, and featured on the DLIR's website <https://labor.hawaii.gov/>

Questions for Consideration:

- What are the jobs in Hawaii that we don't have anymore (past)?
- What are the jobs that you find more interesting today (present)?
- What would be the best job you can think of doing one day (future)?

The deadline to submit an entry is 6 p.m. **Wednesday, November 13**

All drawings shall be two-dimensional and no larger than 30 inches high and 30 inches wide, be original in concept, design, and execution, and may not violate any U.S. copyright laws.

All work entered must be in its original medium. **Please note that artwork will not be returned.**

Acceptable mediums for two-dimensional (2D) artwork include:

- Paintings (oil, acrylics, watercolor, etc.)
- Drawings (color pencil, pencil, ink, marker, pastels, and charcoal)
- Collages (must be two dimensional)
- Photographs
- Computer-generated art
- Mixed Media (use of more than one medium)

For photographs and digital images:

JPG Files: JPG files should be captured by a high-resolution camera.

Image size: Each JPG shall be at least **3600 x 2700** pixels

Image quality: 300 dpi

File Size: Each JPG shall be at least 1 megabyte and not exceed 10 megabytes.
