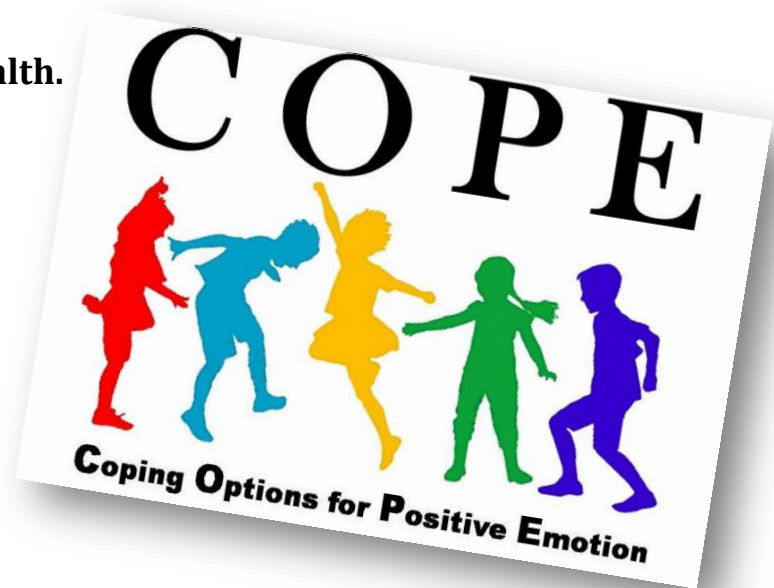
Coping Options for Positive Emotion (COPE)
