What is the Kentucky Immunization Registry (KYIR)?

The Kentucky Immunization Registry (KYIR) is a web-based, statewide system that collects and reports immunization data.

KYIR can receive and send data securely to ensure privacy, confidentiality and accuracy.

How can your child care center benefit from using KYIR?

By logging on and using KYIR, you can:

- Print immunization certificates (no PCP signature required!)
- Print new certificates that have been short-dated on expiration
- Locate missing immunization records
- Access records of students transferring in from other areas of Kentucky
- Reduce phone calls to parents and medical providers
