

Board Member vacancy announcement

Florence, AL—The Florence City Board of Education will begin accepting letters of interest from qualified residents of District 4 who wish to be considered for membership on the Board to fill the unexpired term due to the death of William S. Gullett. A map of District 4 boundaries is available at the City of Florence, City Clerk's office.

To be qualified, an applicant must be a registered voter and a current resident of District 4. Additionally, an applicant must be at least 21 years of age and a resident of District 4 for at least the past six months. An applicant shall not be an employee of the Florence City Board of Education or have a record of conviction for any crime involving moral turpitude. The individual appointed to fill the unexpired term will serve the remainder of the current term which will end on November 10, 2020.
