1-20 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED  
 1-21 AN ACT

1-22 relating to a prohibition on contractors acting as public insurance  
 1-23 adjusters in certain circumstances.

1-24 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-25 SECTION 1. The heading to Section 4102.163, Insurance Code,  
 1-26 is amended to read as follows:

1-27 Sec. 4102.163. CERTAIN CONTRACTOR [~~ROOFING-RELATED~~]  
 1-28 BUSINESS PROHIBITED.

1-29 SECTION 2. Section 4102.163(a), Insurance Code, is amended  
 1-30 to read as follows:

1-31 (a) A [~~roofing~~] contractor may not act as a public adjuster  
 1-32 or advertise to adjust claims for any property for which the  
 1-33 contractor is providing or may provide contracting [~~roofing~~]  
 1-34 services, regardless of whether the contractor:

- 1-35 (1) holds a license under this chapter; or
- 1-36 (2) is authorized to act on behalf of the insured under  
 1-37 a power of attorney or other agreement.

1-38 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.

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
