CTA Hall of Fame Eligibility



Nominators

All toy industry professionals are eligible to submit candidates for consideration (living or posthumous). Membership in the Canadian Toy Association is not required for submitting a nomination.

Candidates

Consideration for the Canadian Toy Association's Hall of Fame shall be for individuals (living or posthumous) who have made outstanding contributions and/or provided outstanding service to the toy industry in Canada. This can be in the manufacturing, distribution or retail category within the toy industry. The candidate(s) should have a minimum of three of the following accomplishments:

- Long experience and record of accomplishment in the industry.
- Innovative product, marketing introductions or significant process improvements.
- Active involvement in the Committees or work of the Canadian Toy Association.
- Demonstrated commitment to ethical practices.
- Charitable efforts benefiting children and/or children's causes.
- An unimpeachable record of integrity and respect in the industry.
- Promoting the public's awareness of the toy industry as a significant and responsible business community member.

Consideration will also be given to the number of nominations received from the Canadian Toy Association membership.

The Canadian Toy Association is committed to creating a diverse and inclusive environment. All qualified nominees will receive consideration without regard to race, colour, religion, gender identity or expression, sexual orientation, national origin, genetics, disability, or age.

The Canadian Toy Association staff will tally the voting results and provide a summary to members of the Hall of Fame Committee for verification. Results of the ballot shall then be provided to the Canadian Toy Association Board of Directors. The Board will confirm the number of individuals it would like to induct into the Hall of Fame.

The Hall of Fame Committee may also carry forward leading vote recipients from the prior year's ballot to be inducted in the following year by providing prior notice to the Board of Directors. In this case, a new ballot will not be distributed.

Presentation Ceremony

The 2026 Inductee(s) will be honoured at the CTA Annual Gala Event, to be held in November 2026; details to follow.

An announcement of the 2026 Inductees will be made in the fall.
