

## See a Fuller Patient Picture with ePDMP Integration through WISHIN Pulse

WISHIN has completed its integration with the state's Enhanced Prescription Drug Monitoring Program (ePDMP). The service is now live for all WISHIN Pulse clients who have elected the PDMP- integration option. The integration means that a patient's prescription history for controlled substances can be accessed from within the WISHIN Pulse system, without separately logging on to the ePDMP or searching for the patient.

In 2014, WISHIN was the first health information exchange (HIE) in the nation to connect to a state Prescription Drug Monitoring Program. To continue delivering this easy access to its participants, on December 7, 2017, the WISHIN Pulse Community Health Record fully integrated with Wisconsin's updated PDMP—the Enhanced Prescription Drug Monitoring Program (ePDMP). Easy access to the ePDMP is essential now that Wisconsin law requires prescribers to consult the ePDMP before writing prescriptions for any of the medications listed in the state's database. Access through WISHIN Pulse allows prescribers to make their decision in the context of the patient's clinical history. More information is available [here](#).

Accessing the ePDMP through WISHIN offers unique value and is almost certainly less expensive than direct integration between an EHR and the ePDMP system.
