WHAT IS THIS STUDY ABOUT?

- This study will assess whether SilverBills, which provides bill management, budgeting, and secure legal document storage services, can decrease dementia caregiver stress, and increase quality of life.
- Participants will be enrolled, free of charge, in the service for approximately one year.
- Caregivers will simply complete a 20 minute questionnaire twice: once before enrolling and once upon completion.
- Participation is fully remote and can be completed from home.
