PROPOSAL DEADLINE: February 5, 2021

Your proposal should include the following information:

- Name, title
- Company/organization/university name, address, website
- Contact info, including email, work/cell phone
- Short bio outlining education and experience
- Resume/CV
- The workshop track you are choosing and a brief description of your topic/session
- Three or four session objectives
- Bibliography (articles/reports published within the last five years that support your work and the session topic)
