

Internships Funding for Workers and Students – March 1 deadline

The International Plant Propagators' Society-Eastern Region Foundation (IPPS-ERF) is proud to offer funds to support **internship experiences** related to nursery production, plant propagation, or plant collections for students or nursery and gardens employees with 5 years or less experience. Grants are for up to \$1,000 to support travel, housing, wages, or educational expenses (such as a conference or specific training) to enhance their overall internship experience. The successful candidate(s) will receive the grant in the form of a reimbursement for expenses incurred during the internship experience. Receipts are required. The deadline for submitting a proposal is **March 1, 2021**.

Proposals should include your resume, the name of a contact person from the company, garden or institution where the candidate will work, the purpose for the funding request, and a detailed budget. You can apply online [here](#)

Successful applicants will be notified by **March 15**. Successful candidates are encouraged to present their experience at an annual IPPS-Eastern Region Conference and are **required to provide a** one-page report on their experience for the IPPS-ER Newsletter and Proceedings.
