TOPICS: During the training sessions, participants will develop a basic working knowledge and understanding about topics related to serving on a board, coalition or committee. Training topics include the following:

3. Communications, Confidentiality & Board Ethics
4. Functions of a Nonprofit Board
5. Government Committees, Nonprofit Committees, Commissions, Task Forces & Councils
6. Networking and Developing Community Contacts

Upon completion of the Leadership Academy, SIL will work with participants to identify areas of interest and potential opportunities for hands-on internship experiences in the community.
