Beginning **Monday, April 13**, students at Sheboygan Falls High School will begin following a “block schedule” as follows:

Day of Week	Periods
<b>Monday and Wednesday</b>	1, 2, 3, 4
<b>Tuesday and Thursday</b>	5, 6, 7
<b>Friday</b>	Work Day/Catch Up Day with Office Hours
<b>** Please note that the exception to the above schedule could be a college-level course, such as CAPP and/or AP, which is required to meet more frequently. Your teacher will notify you of the exception if you are in these courses.</b>	

As part of Virtual Learning, all students are expected to participate online utilizing their student Google and Canvas accounts as they will be the primary format for communicating, assigning, and submitting coursework. Any links to external websites or documents will be provided by teachers along with access to any lectures or discussions. Some classes may require a virtual meeting while all teachers will be providing virtual office hours on Fridays as part of the work day format.
