

2020 S.G.C.C. JUNIOR GOLF INFORMATION

1. Only children of families with a Full Family SGCC membership can participate in Junior Golf.
2. **Fee:** \$70 per child; \$50 for each additional child in the family.
3. Minimum Age: born in the year 2012
4. Maximum Age: 18 years old or a 2020 high school graduate
5. Junior golfers and volunteers **must** arrive and sign-in at **least 15 minutes early**.
6. Junior golfers must play in their age group and on the scheduled date for their tournament. Any exceptions to age groups must be approved by Coach Ann prior to registration.
7. Junior golfers must participate in at least **three** of the six Tuesday play days to be eligible for prizes in their tournaments.
8. Junior golfers must have their own clubs and bags. A few golf clubs/bags have been donated to the Junior Golf program and may be borrowed.
9. Junior golfers who are caught purposely damaging the course at any time will be banned from participating in the SGCC Junior Golf Program for the remainder of the season.

No exceptions to this rule and no second chances!!!

AGE GROUPS, TIMES, DATES, and TOURNAMENTS

Ages 8-11 as of June 1, 2020 play at 7:30-9:00 a.m. on Tuesday play days.

Ages 12-18 as of June 1, 2020 play at 9:30-11:00 a.m. on Tuesday play days.

June 16th: play day/lesson
June 23rd: play day/lesson
June 30th: play day/lesson

July 7th: "Fun Day"
July 14th: play day/lesson
TOURNAMENT, LUNCH & AWARDS
July 21st: ages 8-11 (7:30-11:30)
July 28th: ages 12-18 (7:30-11:30)

Ages 8-11 end-of-the-season tournament: 9 holes using the junior tee markers

Ages 12-18 end-of-the-season tournament: 9 holes using the regulation tee markers. The boy and girl winners of the July 28th tournament will be the SGCC Junior Golf Club Champions.

Children born any time in 2012 are invited to play in Junior Golf.

Maximum of 50 Junior Golfers in each age group.

1. The first Junior Golf day (June 9th) is **mandatory** and will include etiquette, rules, and fitness.
2. Each week, during a regular play day, the kids will experience half of the time playing and the other half in lessons with Ann Wolta Blackstone, SGCC's LPGA Teaching Professional.
3. A new golf rule will be taught each week.
4. "Fun Day" will include a free pancake breakfast.

2020 S.G.C.C. JUNIOR GOLF PROGRAM VOLUNTEER INFORMATION

YOU are a critical element for the success of SGCC Junior Golf!

1. Every family is required to provide four (4) volunteer sessions.
-A session is approximately 1 ½ hours per session
2. Volunteers **must** sign-in at least 15 minutes before a Tuesday session to earn credit.
3. Volunteers must be at least 18 years of age.
4. Volunteer duties may include:
-Walking with and keeping score for a group of 2-4 players during play days/tournaments
-Set-up for orientation day; Fun Day; Pancake breakfast
5. A minimum of 20 volunteers are needed for each end-of-the-season tournament:
-2 walkers/scorers for each of the nine holes
-2 volunteers to post tournament scores
-3 hours of tournament play equals two (2) volunteer sessions
6. Volunteer deposit in lieu of completing volunteer sessions will be used for:
-program expenses
-the annual SGCC Scholarship awarded to a qualified graduating senior

Every family is **required to volunteer 4 sessions** during the Junior Golf Program. Each session is approximately 1 ½ hours. Every family will pay the \$100 Volunteer fee online when registering their child. If you do not volunteer 4 times, you will not receive a refund for any portion. **We need parent volunteers every week to make the junior golf program a success!!!!** We appreciate your support and commitment to volunteer 4 times during the program.
