



## Elementary Summer Work (incoming 2nd graders)

We want to make sure that all the wonderful skills you've learned this year will remain sharp! We hope this information will help you understand our expectations for incoming students at the 2nd grade level, as well as provide you with some fun and varied ways to review and enhance your knowledge.

Your 2<sup>nd</sup> grader should ...

Math:

- be able to add and subtract numbers through 24.
- have memorized addition facts through 12.
- have a basic understanding of place value through the hundredths place.
- be able to apply problem-solving strategies to solve word problems.
- understand and use symbols (+, -, <, >, =) correctly.

Language Arts:

- read silently and independently for a sustained period of time (at least 20 minutes).
- read grade level material aloud with fluency and expression.
- understand basic spelling rules.
- use phonics to decode or spell unknown words.
- speak and write using correct grammar (nouns, verbs, etc.).
- write a well written sentence using COPS.
- use correct pencil grip and writing posture.
- correctly and legibly form all upper and lower case letters
- be able to work cooperatively in a group, follow instructions, and treat supplies with respect.

Religion:

- know basic prayers such as the Our Father and Hail Mary.
- understand how to use a Rosary. • be able to genuflect and correctly make the sign of the cross.
- exhibit good behavior at Mass by listening, responding, singing, and praying.
