

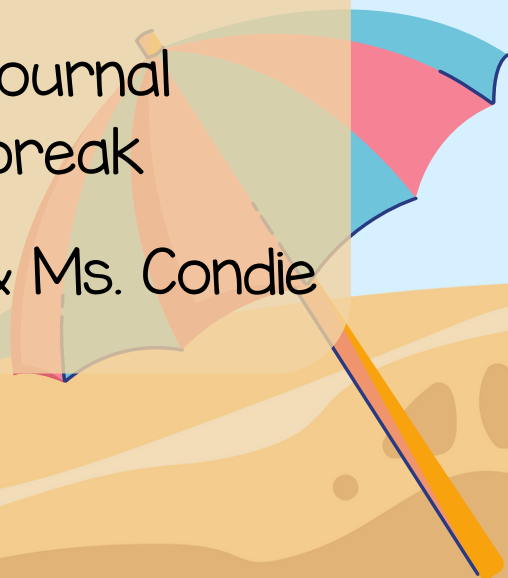
# Summer Homework
