



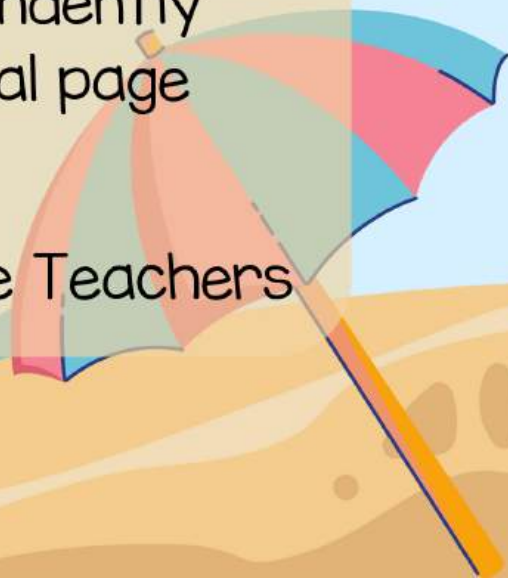

- Extra credit: Write a journal page about summer break

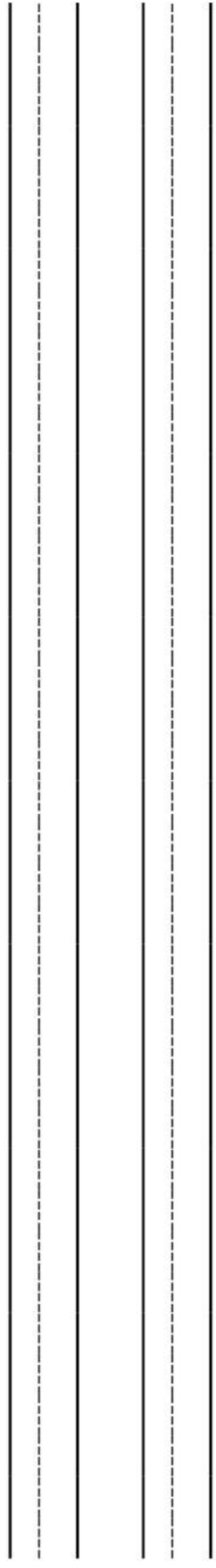
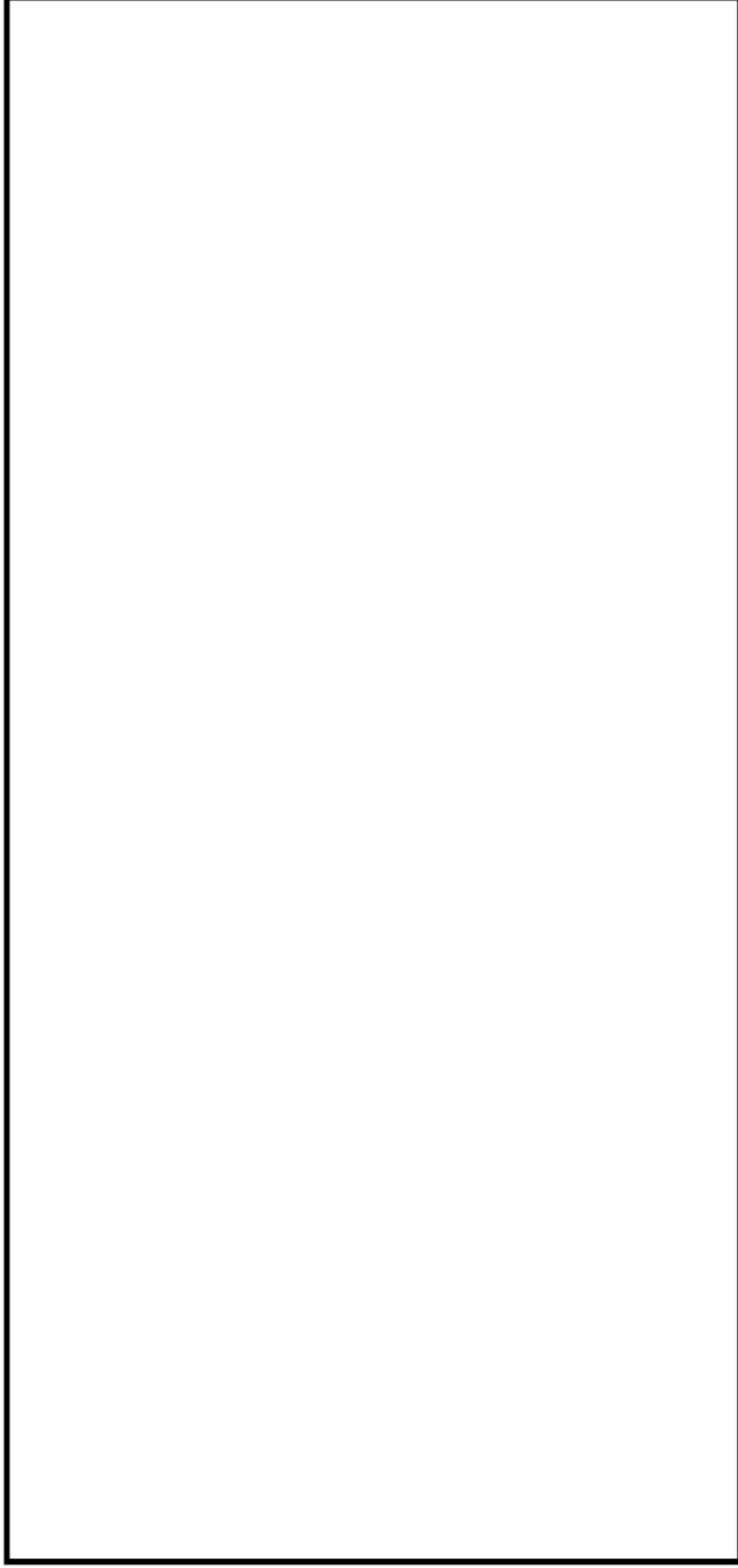
