Required summer work: **20 minutes of Reflex every day. Students should start the year with 100% in Reflex.** For further practice you might consider going back 3rd grade skills in IXL in which you didn't get to a smartscore of 100 to practice.

Language Arts

- Read at grade level
- Write complete sentences with proper capitalization and punctuation
- Write an organized three paragraph essay independently
- Correctly and legibly write in both print and cursive
