### MEASURE DEFINITION

This measure identifies members who turned 30 months old and who had at least 2 well-child visits between their first 15- 30 months of life

### NUMERATOR

Members in the denominator who have had at least 2 office visits during their first 15-30 months of life.

### DENOMINATOR

Members who turned 30 months old.

### HEDIS MEASURE

This measure is a HEDIS measure.

The Healthcare Effectiveness Data and Information Set (HEDIS) is one of health care's most widely used performance improvement tools used by more than 90 percent of U.S. health plans to measure performance on important dimensions of care and service.

### TECHNICAL SPECIFICATIONS:

#### Numerator

- At least 2 claims for well-care visits during their first 15 -30 months of life. Visits must be made by a Primary Care Provider. Visits within 6 days' interval will be counted as one visit.

#### Denominator

- Members who turned 30 months old as of the last day of the Measurement Period
- AND have medical eligibility between 31 days and 15 months of age, with no more than 1 gap of no more than 45 days
