Sermon

"I am the Door" – John 10:1-10
Rev. Justin Poythress

"Truly, truly, I say to you, he who does not enter the sheepfold by the door but climbs in by another way, that man is a thief and a robber. 2 But he who enters by the door is the shepherd of the sheep. 3 To him the gatekeeper opens. The sheep hear his voice, and he calls his own sheep by name and leads them out. 4 When he has brought out all his own, he goes before them, and the sheep follow him, for they know his voice. 5 A stranger they will not follow, but they will flee from him, for they do not know the voice of strangers." 6 This figure of speech Jesus used with them, but they did not understand what he was saying to them.

7 So Jesus again said to them, "Truly, truly, I say to you, I am the door of the sheep. 8 All who came before me are thieves and robbers, but the sheep did not listen to them. 9 I am the door. If anyone enters by me, he will be saved and will go in and out and find pasture. 10 The thief comes only to steal and kill and destroy. I came that they may have life and have it abundantly.

Main idea: Go through Jesus to find abundant life.

- 1) Who is Jesus?
- 2) Who are thieves?
- 3) Are you finding abundant life?

Community Group Questions:

- 1) Are there any scams you have been almost taken in by? What makes a scam persuasive?
- 2) Are there any ways you hear people today falsely claiming to represent Jesus and his will? What does that look or sound like?
- 3) How do attempts at spiritual leadership / guidance outside of Jesus and the gospel always end up being about personal gain rather than about giving life?
- 4) How do you think most people would define abundant life? What is attractive about that? Where does it fall short?
- 5) How can the truth that God wants us to have abundant life be both challenging and transforming?

Communion

Just as the climax of all history will be the Wedding Supper of the Lamb, we conclude our worship in the presence of God by feasting. The Spirit takes the common elements of bread and wine and feeds us spiritually with the body and blood of Jesus, for our nourishment and growth in grace, and so strengthens us to be sent out into the world as God's agents of his generous hospitality.

You will be asked to come forward and receive the bread (gluten free bread will be in the plastic cups) and wine (grape juice is on the outer rings) from the elders and deacons. Please take the elements back to your seats and we will then partake together. Those unable to come forward will be served at their seats.

We ask that you dispense with your cups by the back door following the service.

The Lord's Supper, also called Communion or the Eucharist, is the family meal of Christians. We invite all baptized followers of Jesus Christ who acknowledge their sins against God and their neighbors, and confess their need for the grace of Christ to partake of this meal. If you are a Christian and haven't been baptized, please talk with one of our pastors. We would be honored to baptize you.

It is right to give him thanks and praise.


