

Mystery Quilt Spring 2019

Yankee Pride is pleased to announce the design description and fabric yardages for the Spring 2019 Mystery Quilt. As always, the quilt comes in three size: Wall, Throw/Twin, and Queen.

This is a classic medallion-style quilt, with a large center design and concentric rows of pieced designs around it. The techniques we are using this time are Flying Geese, Half-square triangles, and Square-in-a-Square.

Flying Geese units are used extensively in this quilt, for making shapes other than star points. And you will be making A LOT of them. If you don't enjoy making Flying Geese, you may want to sit out this round. But if you do like making them, you'll be very pleased by the end result – you'll be making a stunning, show-worthy, heirloom quilt.

For ALL fabrics in this quilt, tone-on-tone fabrics, solids, or small-scale, subtle prints will work best.

You will need four fabrics for this quilt:

Background 1 (a light fabric – white in our diagrams)

Background 2 (a medium/light fabric – gray in our diagrams)

Accent (a medium/dark fabric – red in our diagrams)

Design (a dark fabric – black in our diagrams)

The outer border for all sizes is the design fabric. There should be good contrast between all the colors, because they are all next to each other somewhere in the quilt.

Yardages are listed below:

Wall Hanging (44" x 44")	Throw/Twin Size (62" x 92")	Queen (98" x 98")
Background 1: ½ yard	Background 1: 1½ yards	Background 1: 1¾ yards

Rulers needed: Wing Clipper I

Tucker Trimmer I

Square² (Only needed for Throw/Twin and Queen. If you don't have one, there is one here at the shop that can be borrowed. It's only used for a few pieces.)
