“An opportunity has come up for me to partner with RIPSOT to deliver hand sanitizer to people that really need it and our front line heroes. My dad has been at GNGH (Greater Niagara General Hospital) helping people for almost 25 years and its time we went to bat for the nurses and doctors right here in Niagara.” Says Harpur from his Niagara home.

RIPSOT, a local Niagara based company that packages liquids in the spirit industry have shifted focus to help fight the COVID-19 pandemic in the Niagara Region and across Canada. They are now running 24 hours, packaging hand sanitizer, filling orders and shipping them worldwide.

RIPSOT and Harpur have teamed up to deliver much needed hand sanitizer to Greater Niagara General Hospital front line staff, doctors, paramedics and patients.

RIPSOT will be producing 500 ML bottles in which will be sold at a discounted rate of \$8.50 per bottle. Bottles can be purchased via email and will be delivered to Businesses and homes in Niagara within the next 2 weeks.

Financial donations will help purchase units for GNGH. A simple \$100 Donation buys one case and each case purchased will be matched by Ben Harpur.
