



Keystone STARS Support Online Course “Assessment: Beyond the Basics of Observation and Data Utilization” Now Available in the PD Registry!

The course **Assessment: Beyond the Basics of Observation and Data Utilization** provides an overview of classroom assessments of young children and how information from assessments can be used to inform instruction. Learners will explore four basic types of assessment: Screening, Diagnostic, Formative and Summative. They will use observation as an assessment strategy. And they will use child assessment data by employing the *Interpret-Act-Communicate* model.

This course is offered for four one-hour sessions. Lessons must be taken sequentially and learner must successfully complete the final test for each lesson in order to get PQAS hours for the course.
