To register please visit www.pakeys.org: You can use the calendar search method and enter the program start date to find the course. Or, you can use the catalog search method and enter "HACC". This will bring up several HACC courses; choose the Funded CDA Course as indicated by the "Key" storefront icon.

Cost: \$250 application fee: Covers the Pa Keys registration fee, cost of the 120 hours of instruction, all textbooks required for the course, CDA application materials, and 9 college credits if you are registered as a HACC student.

Please note that this fee is now split into two payments: You will pay the \$50 registration fee on the PA Keys PD Registry using approved payment options and will pay the additional \$200 directly to HACC using check, VISA, Master Card or Discover.
