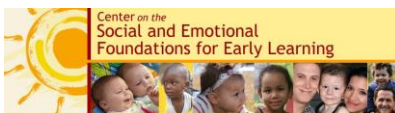
Description: The Eco-Healthy Childcare© curriculum is brought to you in partnership with OCDEL and the PA Chapter of the American Academy of Pediatrics' Early Childhood Linkage System (ECELS). Over the course of 2012, Eco-Healthy Childcare© underwent a lengthy review process to assure that all content is aligned with the American Academy of Pediatrics' Council of Environmental Health and contemporary research. Eco-Healthy Childcare© is a nationally-recognized, science-based, pediatric environmental health program that is tailored to child care programs of all types. The goal of Eco-Healthy Childcare© is to introduce child care program directors (or those who have decision-making authority within their facilities) to the most common environmental hazards that may be present in their programs. This information will give Pennsylvania early learning programs powerful information that can reduce or eliminate the likelihood that children and/or staff are exposed to these particular environmental toxins. At the conclusion of this training session participants will evaluate their own programs by completing the Eco-Healthy Child Care Checklist.
