### NOVEMBER CALENDAR

#### October 31st-November 13th

**Marketing Your Child Care-** (6 clock hours) **D8.17 C1**-This training is designed for program owners and directors. This class features many concrete ideas and will guide participants in developing an effective marketing and promotion strategy for their program. *Note: Part of the clock hours of this class requires a hands-on activity to reinforce class objectives* (6 clock hours)

**Classroom Environments: Setting the Stage for Play and Learning** (3 clock hours) **K2.3 C2**- You have a great opportunity to shape the experiences and learning of children in your care just by how you arrange the environment. This class will show how the environment can influence and support your program goals. You will also learn specific strategies to help you design a great place for children to learn and play! This class is designed for providers in toddler and preschool classrooms.

**Open the Door to Outdoor Fun and Learning**-(1 clock hour) **K2.4 C1**- Research shows that children are spending half as much time outside as they did 20 years ago – and much more time doing “inside” activities. This class will highlight the many benefits of outdoor activities and show the student how to promote fun and learning in an outdoor setting.

#### November 11th Webinar Day!

**Every Child Is Unique-online class** (3 clock hours) **K1.7 C1**This training is designed for caregivers and educators of children of all ages. Students will learn how to recognize individual behavioral and learning styles and adapt learning activities and experiences appropriately.

**Routines and Relationships** (2 clock hour) **K2.9 C1**-This training is designed for caregivers and educators of infants and toddlers. Participants will learn how responsive care giving forms the foundation of building relationships, and sets the stage for development and learning.

### **November 14th-27th**

**Reporting Concerns** (3 clock hours) **K3.4 C1**-This online training is designed for caregivers and educators and administrators of child care programs or schools. Students will learn how to determine when and how to best approach families when they have a concern about a child's development or behavior and wish to make a referral.

**Recruiting Child Care Staff- online class** (4 clock hours) **D8.11 C1** This online training is designed for child care and early childhood directors. This class covers ways to recruit quality staff members and teachers.

**Managing Mixed Age Groups in a Child Care Setting** (5 clock hours) **D1.7 C2** This training is designed for child care providers who deal with different ages in the same setting. Participants will learn to manage mixed age groups in a child care setting. *Note: Part of the clock hours of this class requires interaction with children to reinforce class objectives*
